Common wasps build paper nests, often building their nests in high up places or nooks. Common wasps are adapted to be able to live and nest in very humid areas, wide-ranged environments, or man-made structures like gardens, the overhangs of roofs, benches, etc. Knowing where wasps are can help you by making it so you can make sure where you go next you can stay safe. though not inherently aggressive, much like other wasp species, common wasps release an alarm phenomenon when they are killed that attracts other wasps, which can lead to a swarm if there are many wasps nearby. It's recommended to generally leave wasps alone when you see them out and about.

Ground BeetlesBy Charlie Smith

Ground Beetles are beetles in the large family Carabidae. They are not pollinators but they are still important to gardens.

Why are They Important?

Ground beetles are important because they eat many common garden pests. This helps because these pests eat plants that we are trying to keep healthy.

Ground Beetle Facts

Tiger beetles which can run at speeds of up to 5.6 miles per hour when hunting although it needs to stop a lot because it can't see its prey when running.

Ground beetles can eat thousands of bugs in a lifetime. One species, the colorful ground beetle *Lebia grandis* can also mate and make up to 1300 ground beetle larvae which can eat bugs as larvae and then turn into ground beetles just like lepidoptera (moths and butterflies) Diptera (flies) hymenoptera (ants, bees, wasp, and sawflies.) and many other insects that are holometabolous and go through a complete metamorphosis (egg, larva, pupa, adult,).

How can you help them?

You can help them by planting plants in the family Fabaceae (legumes) such as clover, alfalfa, hairy vetch, scotch broom, or edible plants such as beans or peanuts. These plants are nitrogen fixers and they are very attractive to ground beetles. You could also lay out several boards or rocks next to your garden to provide shelter for ground beetles.

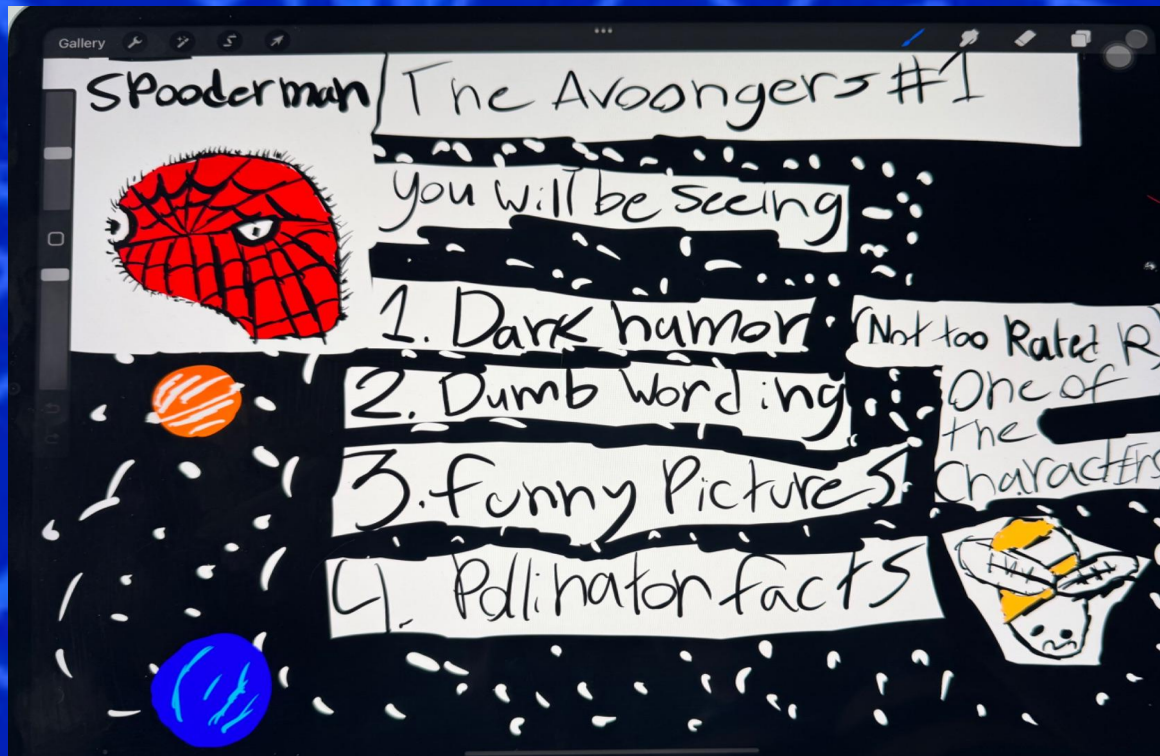

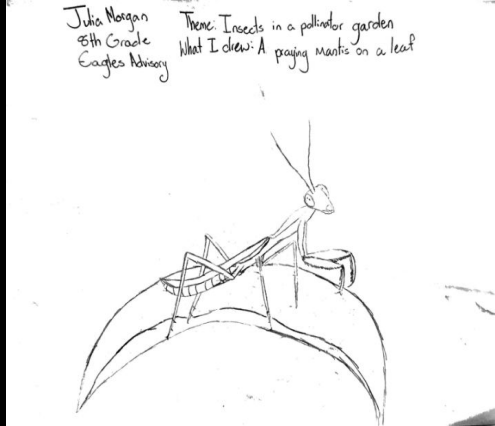

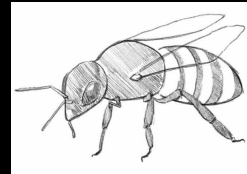
This week we interviewed Ms. Kathy.

She said: "I would say take your time, and really use your imagination. Do your best, and be creative."

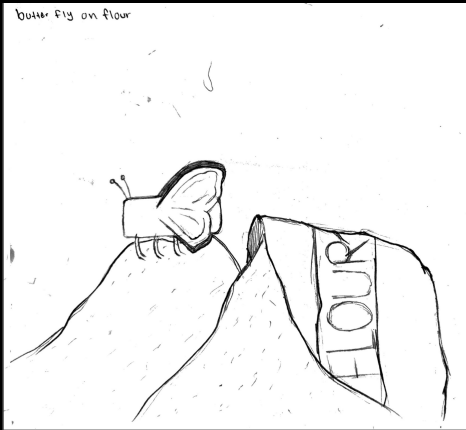

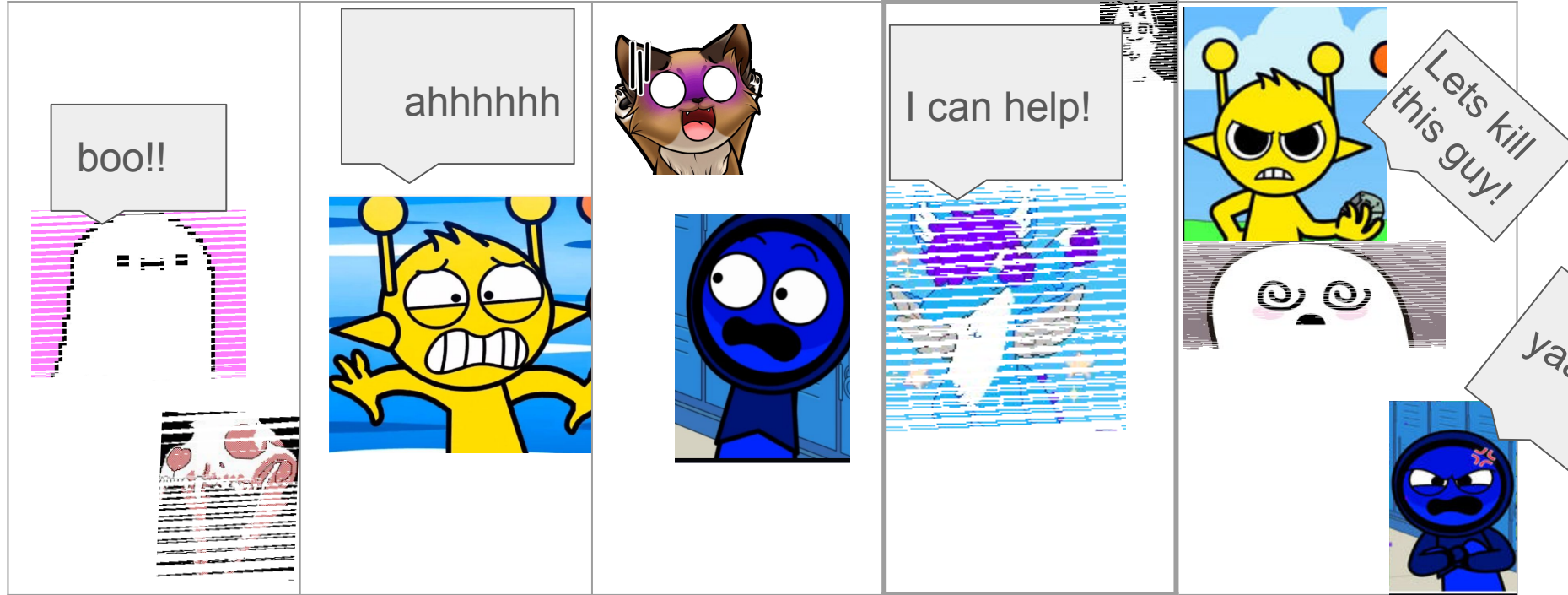

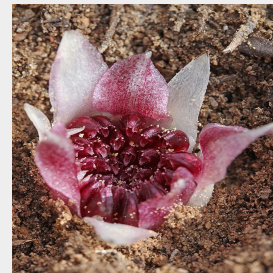
